- > **Patrol Meetings:** Thursday evenings, 6:15-7:45 p.m.
- Corpus Christi School cafeteria (2410 North Cascade, Colorado Springs, 80907)
- Woodland Trails: Elementary School
 - Fox Patrol (K 1 st) at least 5 years old AND in Kindergarten
 - Hawk Patrol (2nd 3rd) at least 7 years old
 - Mountain Lion Patrol (4th 5th) at least 9 years old
- > Navigators: Middle School 6-8th Grade, at least 11 years old
- > Adventurers: High School 9-12th Grade, at least 14 years old

We Need Your Help

- ★ (K-5th) All Woodlands Trails Families are encouraged to have one parent register as a Registered Adult / Leader where at all possible. Parents of Foxes (K-1st) are asked to stay on campus and aid in the Fox patrol, unless they are leading elsewhere.
- ★ Trail Guides: Registered Adults (age 18 or over) who assist the Ranger, Trailmaster, or Advisor in delivering the troop program.
- ★ Trail Badge Mentors: Registered Adults who provide Trail Badge training to Trailmen in the Navigators and Adventures Patrols.
- ★ Administrative Help:
 - Advancement & Attendance Helper for Woodland Trails and Navs/Advs (track attendance/badges)
 - Woodland Trails Events Coordinator(s) and Servant Event Coordinator
 - o Communications/Calendar manager within Troop Track and announcements
 - Health and Safety Coordinator to manage forms and follow up
 - Onboarding/Membership Coordinator to help get people registered/onboarded in Trooptrack and TLC
 - **Uniform Coordinator** to help ordering correct sizes and start a trade-in program
 - Fundraising Coordinator to offset membership dues, we require an annual fundraising event
